CALL TO ORDER

Commission Chairman Robert Koch called the Franklin County Commissioners' Regular Board Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the Franklin County Courthouse located at 1016 North Fourth Avenue, Pasco, Washington.

Commissioners Present: Commission Chair Robert Koch, Chair Pro Tem Brad Peck and Member Rick Miller was excused.

Commissioner Koch led the Pledge of Allegiance

Planning Director Loren Wiltse presented the Board with a Conditional Use Permit 2017-01 Construction of an Assisted Living Facility.

After a brief discussion Commissioner Peck moved to approve CUP 2017-01 subject to the 6 findings of fact, 9 conditions of approval and one additional requirement not specified in this package.
